The modern people on the move will carry all kind of communication gadgets and wants to be online 24/7. Running out of battery capacity is not an option.

The "Sifti" solar bag made by Globe Hope is the answer for mobile power needs. The bag has integrated solar panels, a battery pack and solar harvesting module developed by Suntrica Ltd., Finland. The Sifti Bag can charge cellular phones, mp3 players, GPS receivers, digital cameras etc. You just connect the device to Sifti Bag with a cable on the go. The bag is made of second hand sails and its shoulder strap is a used car seat belt.

The Sifti solar bag generates electricity by solar panels when the bag is placed outdoors in sunlight. The internal battery (950mAh) will be fully charged in ca. 5.5 hours and it can fully charge an entry level cellular phone and a modern smartphone up to 50%.

When you have charged you device, just take off the charging cable from both the device and solar bag, place the bag to the sun again and it starts to store energy for your later use.

The Sifti solar bag will generate energy also on cloudy conditions, but at slower rate. The bag will have an extraordinary long energy storage time, too. With Sifti bag you will always have energy available!

The world premier of the Sifti solar bag takes place in Helsinki International Boat Show on the 12<sup>th</sup> - 20<sup>th</sup> February in Helsinki, Finland. When you buy a Sifti bag, part of the revenue will be channeled through WWF to Baltic environmental protection program.
